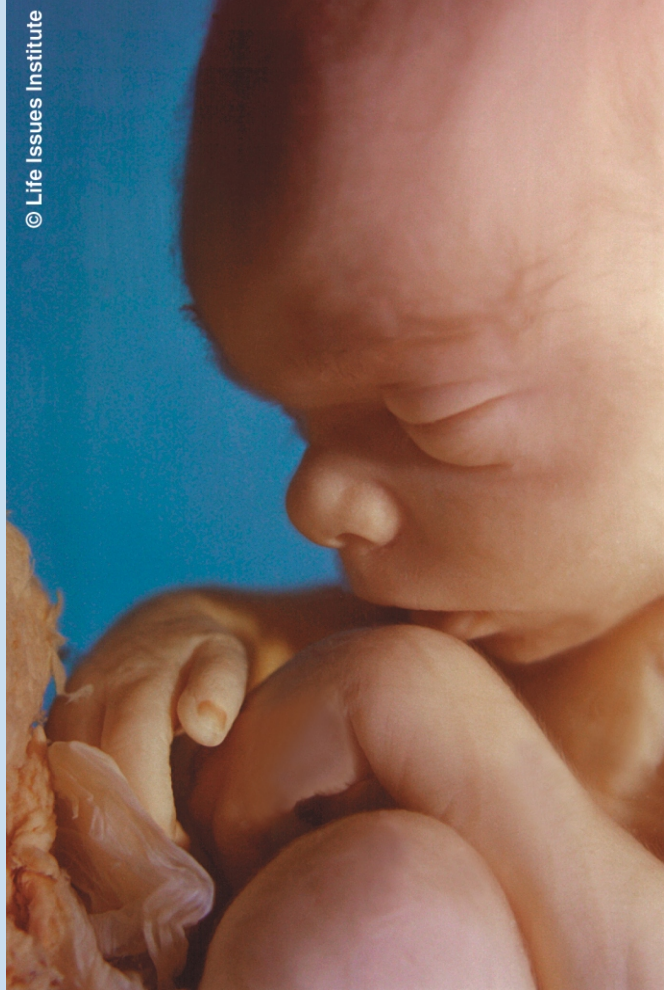


WHAT CAN SHE DO?
