You can help your children become attuned to God's call by familiarizing them with stories from the Gospel; worshiping with the community on Sundays; and praying regularly at meals, bedtime, and in good times and bad. Be a good shepherd; teach your child how to listen for and recognize God's call. God will speak to all who call on him. —Tom McGrath
